

JACK MORGAN'S MIXED FIVE BOWLER EVENT

- 1 **SUMMARY:** 5-Bowler Teams from Citrus District clubs compete in games of Fours, and 2 Pairs. The 3-game Quinnell scores are combined to determine the winner. Jack Morgan, Sun City Lawn Bowls Club Member, is the donor of a perpetual trophy plaque and this tournament shall be played at Sun City Lawn Bowls Club.
- 2 **EVENT DURATION:** One Day
- 3 **ELIGIBILITY:** The Home Club* of each player must be in the Citrus District (Hemet, Pomona, Redlands, Riverside or Sun City)
- 4 **ENTRY QUALIFICATION:** Teams composed of five members who are regular members of the same Citrus District Home Club*. Teams must include at least one member of each gender. Clubs may use their own method of selecting team members. It is the intention of this tournament to have players represent the club they usually represent in other events, and not to join another new club for the sole purpose of playing in this event. No substitution during a game. After the first jack is set, the five members enrolled must play all three games. All players must play at least one game. One member from each team will sit out for each event.
- 5 **MAXIMUM NUMBER OF ENTRIES:** Three teams per club
- 6 **ENTRY FEE:** \$20.00 per player (\$100.00 per team)
- 7 **FORMAT:**
 - Rink numbers assigned by chart and cards - "Blind Draw" for team opponents, Cards (or format) must preclude a team from playing any other team more than once.
 - Three games played: one in the morning, two in the afternoon
 - Morning Games: Fours (Rinks) game will be played
 - Afternoon Games: One Pairs game and One Pairs game (Australian style) - games played concurrently
 - All games played to 14 Ends
- 8 **SCORING:** Quinnell Scoring for all Games (3 points for each game won, 1.5 points for a tie plus 1 point for each end won.) - max points for each game is 17 points
 - First tie breaker - Games won
 - Second tie breaker - Choice of splitting the monies of the places in question combined or coin toss or a one end roll off - if the captains of the teams involved can not agree the monies will be split
 - Last team to enter will be scratched if necessary to avoid byes
- 9 **AWARDS:**
 - **Cash:** The following percentages of the Cash Award Pool will be awarded to the top teams:

	4 thru 9 entries**	10 entries**
1 st Place	60%	55%
2 nd Place	40%	35%
3 rd Place	-	10%
 - **Plaque:** Names of winning team will be engraved on perpetual trophy plaque and presented to the team for display in their club for 6 months. The plaque must then be returned to the sponsor for storage.



* Home Club is the one that pays Southwest Division membership dues. You can not have two home clubs.
 ** The number of entry payouts may vary depending on sponsor contributions.
